



## Edmond de Rothschild, Partner of the Menuhin Festival Gstaad for the 12th consecutive year.

Since 2014, Edmond de Rothschild has been a partner of the Menuhin Festival Gstaad. This 70th edition, under the artistic direction of Daniel Hope, is part of the theme "Family Matters" and will highlight the links between generations, artists and audiences. A theme that resonates with the history of Edmond de Rothschild, who has been involved in artistic creation for nearly two centuries, from Rossini to Berlioz and Chopin.

"For nearly two centuries, our family has supported artistic and musical creation. In Gstaad, we choose to nurture living legacies: the academies are the beating heart of tomorrow's talents", says Ariane de Rothschild.

Since 2016, Edmond de Rothschild Family Philanthropy has also been a patron of the Menuhin Festival Conducting Academy, directed by Jaap van Zweden and Johannes Schlaefli. A reference incubator for the new generation of conductors, the Academy has trained more than 120 young conductors from more than 60 countries, with a growing number of women among the participants.

Through these two complementary commitments: support for the festival since 2014 and the Academy since 2016, Edmond de Rothschild affirms the same conviction: music is a driving force for creativity, transmission and social cohesion.
